Ash Wednesday Service

Ash Wednesday is March 6. It marks the beginning of the season of Lent. The Lenten season is a period of 40 weekdays when Christians prepare for Easter. Lenten preparations include fasting, repentance, moderation and a renewed focus on the spiritual disciplines. On Ash Wednesday, worshipers are marked with the sign of the cross in ashes on their foreheads. The ashes are a sign of both our mortality and our sinfulness. In remembering our mortality and sinfulness, we realize both were triumphed through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Join us on Ash Wednesday, 6:15pm in the sanctuary as we take our first steps into the Lenten season.
