Dear Church Family:

We continue to follow what Sheriff P.J. Tanner, Governor Henry McMaster and health officials are telling us about the Coronavirus, COVID-19.

All Church Worship, In-person Meetings and Activities are CANCELLED through the end of April.

All Holy Week Activities are CANCELLED to include Holy Thursday Worship, Youth and Children Carrying the Cross, Good Friday Worship followed by Lunch and Annual Easter Egg Hunt. Please tune in to Carteret Street United Methodist Church Facebook Page on Holy Thursday, April 9th for a special message from Rev. Dr. Rebecca Bruff.

Worship and Sunday School are CANCELLED for Easter Sunday, April 12th. Please tune into Carteret Street United Methodist Church Facebook Page on Easter Sunday, April 12th for a special message from Pastor Bryson. The Easter lilies will be placed in the Sanctuary for Easter Sunday, April 12th. Following the message from Pastor Bryson all Easter lilies will be placed on the front steps of the church and you can pick your Easter lily up at your convenience. Also, the Flower Cross will be placed outside the front of the church on the corner of Carteret and North Street. If you feel comfortable being out, please bring flowers to put on the Cross. We ask that you maintain 6' of social distance while doing this.

I would like everyone to read Passion narratives contained in the Gospels. I encourage you to read at least one of the Gospel accounts and if possible read all four. The Passion accounts are recorded in Matthew 21-28; Mark 11-16; Luke 19:28-24 and John 12-21.

The Church Office has limited hours. The door will remain locked at all times. We are limiting the traffic for everyone's health and safety. Please call or email the Church Office rather than visit in person if you have any needs. Email and phone messages are checked daily. Tithes and offerings can continue to be dropped off in the mail slot at the Church Office or mailed in. Please reach out to Pastor Bryson or the Church Office with any questions, concerns or needs.

If you have any symptoms of the Coronavirus, COVID-19, please seek proper medical attention. If you are at high risk or are sick, please stay home and get better. We want to keep everyone safe and healthy!!
