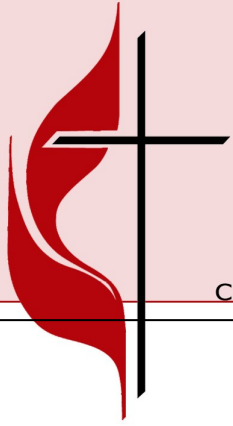

The Bazaar Committee is looking for someone to take on the role as Advertising Chair. If you are interested, please contact the Church Office or Mickey Stoble.

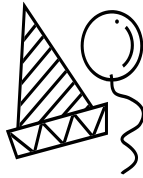
Also, the Handicrafts booth is already planning for this year's bazaar. We need homemade items for this booth. Start making your items now!!

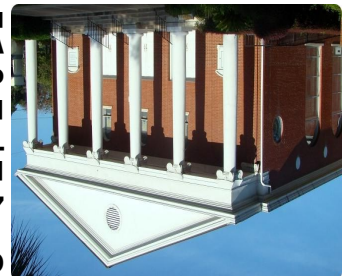
